The numbers are large. . . 500,000 to five million older Americans are abused, neglected or exploited each year according to Barbara E. Riley, former director of the Ohio Department of Aging.

Elder Abuse can occur *anywhere* – in the home, in the nursing homes, or institutions. It has a trait similar to cancer: It affects seniors across all socio-economic groups, cultures, and races.
