- A. St Mary's Development Sponsored event– Steam plant Social Determinacy of Health 10/3/19 www.StMaryDevelopment.org
 - B. Federal reinterpretation of the categorically eligible rule and not looking at resources for the SNAP program. Possibly impacting 9-13% of SNAP recipients.
 - C. FEDS – possible minimum SNAP allotment up to \$50. But if you get below that amount you may loss the SNAP benefits.
 - D. State HB200(?) – SNAP benefits at the state level – No longer allowing ABAWD exemptions. And possibly requiring cooperation with CSEA to receive SNAP
 - E. State legislation – to put Id's on the SNAP cards to try to prevent Fraud.

- F. Reach Out Clinic – suspended the Medical clinics for those without insurance or in the GAP. Pharmacy services still remain open. Manufacturer’s assistance program remains robust. All due to decreased funding over the past 3 years. The Yellow Springs Clinics (for Greene County residents only) remains open.
