- VI. Hot Topics  
A. Medicare Open Enrollment – 10/15/19 – 12/7/19 Vickie Caraher  
1. Medicare is pushing for online enrollment. To enroll online you must have a My Medicare account.  
2. OSHIP reps. will not be keeping the user id's and passwords. It is now taking up to an hour to assist people in selecting new plans. A person can call OSHIP 800-686-1578 and ask for representative in their area to come for a home visit to assist.  
3. Medicare Advantage plans have addition enrollment period of 1/31 – 3/31  
4. Currently the Pricing of Plans functionality is not working. A person can still research plans without having a MyMedicare Account.

5. Some plans have backed out of coverage for the Ohio region. Those individuals that have one of those plans must re-enroll in a new plan.
6. If you currently enrolled – you do not have to re-enroll unless you fall into the above situation.
7. If you need to enroll but fail to, you must wait until next open enrollment and then are charged a penalty. Does not apply if you receive extra help or state buy-in.
