- Aaron discussed the various services that the Dayton Mediation Center provides for the community. Below is a brief description on the services that was shared with the group:

Community Mediation - Helps people feel heard and supports people in finding their way through conflicts.

Juvenile Diversion Mediation - In partnership with the Montgomery County Juvenile Court, allows juveniles who have been charged with an offense, address their charges through mediation, so their record remains clear and provides them an opportunity to learn conflict management.

Landlord/Tenant Program – offers an opportunity for tenants and landlords to discuss problems and address their issues related to eviction court, condition issues, and rental disputes.

Parenting Time Mediation – is offered to parents and other family members struggling with a child visitation schedule, custody issues, and/or, communication issues.

Small Claims Mediation – is an effective option to address your small claims issues before filing your case at the Dayton Municipal Court.

Mediation Response Unit – is an alternative to police response within the City of Dayton that handles low emergency 911, and police calls, involving conflict.

Police Complaint Support Program – this program offers assistance to the community members who have a concern or complaint regarding interactions with the Dayton Police.

*Aaron also mentioned a few education and training opportunities that are offered by the Dayton Mediation Center, listed below:

Conflict Management Training – this program is tailored to a variety of workplaces and ages to help improve your skills on how to respond to conflict.

Speaker's Bureau – this opportunity is geared towards providing a short program that talks about the services, and how to constructively address conflict.
